* There will be no meeting or newsletter in December. We hope you all have a safe and happy holiday season. Our next meeting will be Thursday, January 21st.

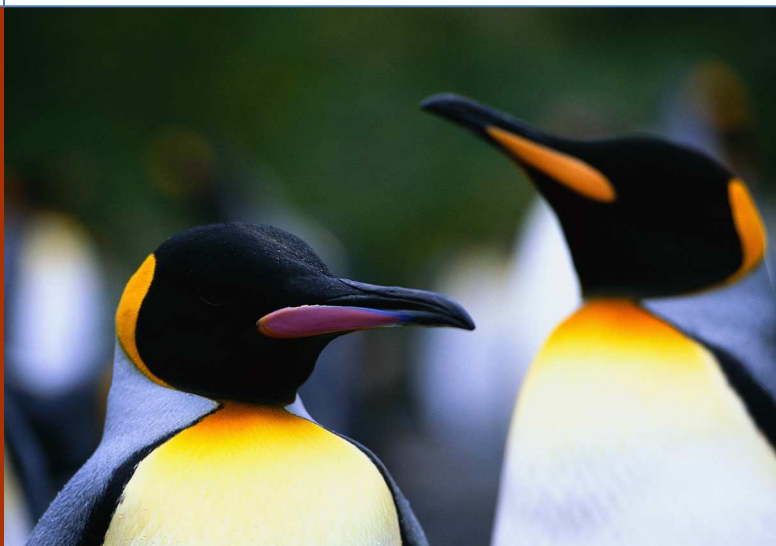

Map To Meeting Place

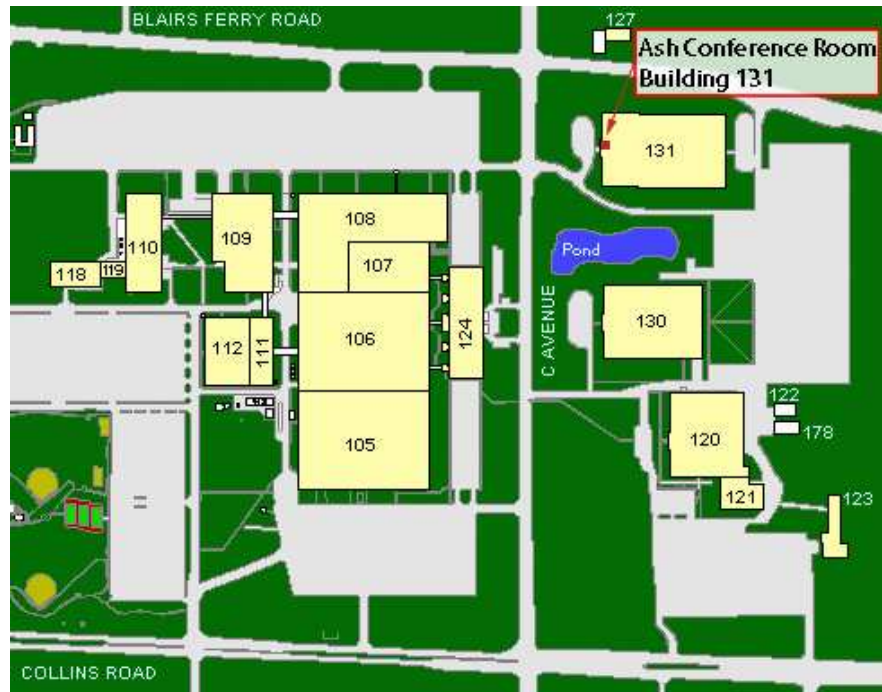
The Collins Photo Club monthly meetings are held in Building 131, in the Ash Conference Room on the Third Thursday of Every Month.
