Map To Meeting Place

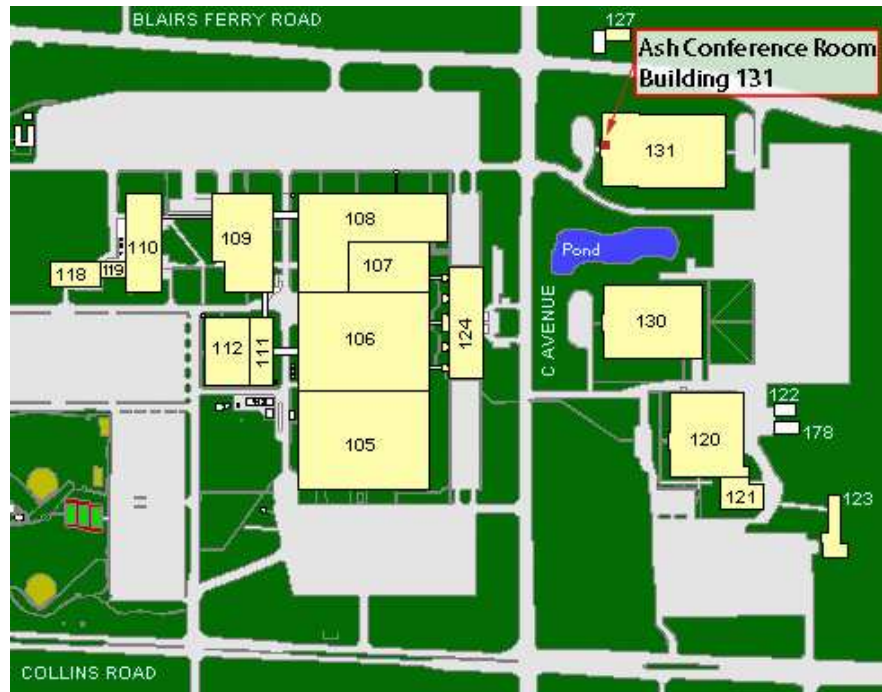
The Collins Photo Club monthly meetings are held in Building 131, in the Ash Conference Room on the Third Thursday of Every Month.
