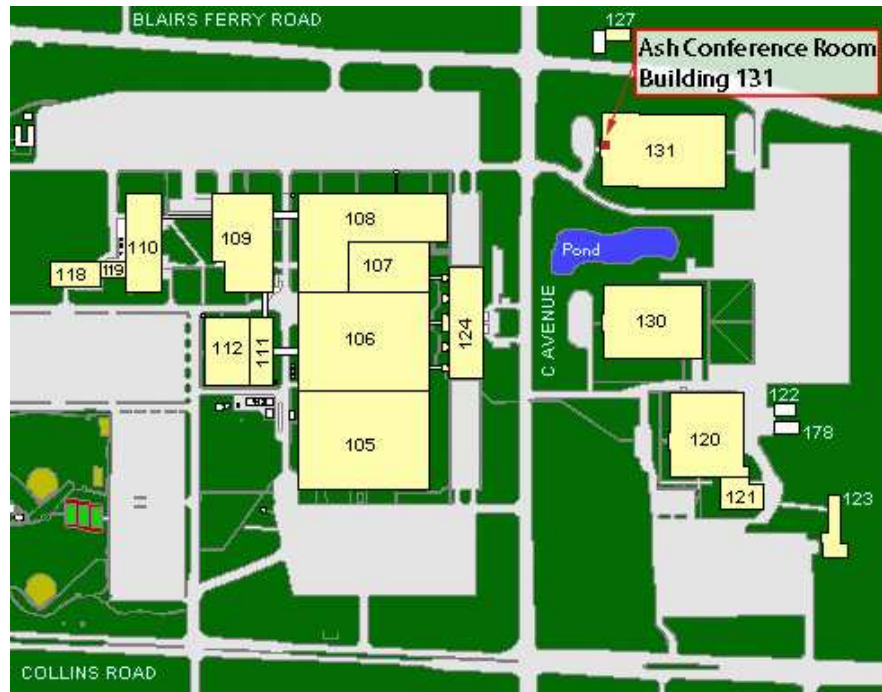
General Information
